From Your Pastor:

Have you ever considered how serious sin really is? Consider this quote from R. C. Sproul:

We try to get around the helplessness of this situation in modern culture by declaring that everybody deserves a second chance. My response is, "Who says so?" Does justice require that everybody get a second chance? A second chance is grace. It is mercy. Grace and mercy are never deserved. So it is nonsense to say that everyone deserves a second chance. But even if that nonsensical, hypothetical condition were true, what good would it do us? How long ago did we use up our second chance?

(The Truth of the Cross, pages 35-36).

How much more amazing grace & mercy become for us when we realize that we absolutely do not deserve them! Our sin deserves punishment & judgment. Yet, God being rich in mercy towards us gives us grace. He makes us His to be His children and exalts us to the heavenly places in Christ.

Consider Romans 5:15, "But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many" (NASB).

How much greater the gift than the sin! How much greater the grace than our deserved judgment! Oh that we would revel in this truth and allow it to dominate everything about our lives. What a difference it would make in our world.
