From Your Pastor:

How is our worship? Consider the words of John Piper from his book *Desiring God*:

Truth without emotion produces dead orthodoxy and a church full (or half-full) of artificial admirers (like people who write generic anniversary cards for a living). On the other hand, emotion without truth produces empty frenzy and cultivates shallow people who refuse the discipline of rigorous thought. But true worship comes from people who are deeply emotional and who love deep and sound doctrine. Strong affections for God rooted in truth are the bone and marrow of biblical worship.

The word worship comes from the idea of worth. It means to revere or honor something because of its great worth. We cannot worship God simply with what we know about Him, nor can we worship God simply in how we feel about Him. Our knowledge of God must affect our emotions; the more we know, then the more we will be affected. In turn, the more we are affected, the more we will want to know. This cycle of both knowing and feeling overflows into vibrant, dynamic worship.

So, how is our worship? Are we actively seeking out truth about God that will affect how we feel about Him? Are these profound emotions driving us to know more about the Lord? Are both of these working together to produce in us an overwhelming sense of awe about God, particularly in relation to His work on our behalf through His Son Jesus? Let us all pray that our worship will be driven by both our minds and our hearts.
