From Your Pastor:

It seems that lately most people in Christian circles want to speak as often as they can of the love of God, with little or no mention to the sin of humanity. There is a very big problem with this, however. Speaking of God's love without its relationship to man's sin makes God's love meaningless. In other words, salvation without the idea of judgment makes no sense.

Consider the following quote, "When we talk about salvation biblically, we have to be careful to state that from which we ultimately are saved. The apostle Paul does just that for us in 1 Thessalonians 1:10, where he says Jesus 'delivers us from the wrath to come.' Ultimately, Jesus died to save us from the wrath of God. We simply cannot understand the teaching and the preaching of Jesus of Nazareth apart from this, for He constantly warned people that the whole world someday would come under divine judgment." (R.C. Sproul, *The Truth of the Cross*, 78-9).

It is very true that God loves us. It is equally true that God holds righteous wrath against sin, that one day will fully be displayed on the sinner. Yet, this is where the love of God, the idea of salvation, begins to make sense. Christ Jesus came to take on our sin, thus receiving the wrath of God for us, and in turn giving us His righteousness, so that we can have a right relationship with God. Without rightly understanding God's wrath and judgment, we wrongly understand God's love and salvation. So today, contemplate both realities of sin and salvation, of love and wrath, of judgment and deliverance. What joy it should bring to each heart, and what a desire it should stir in us to share the Good News that Jesus saves!

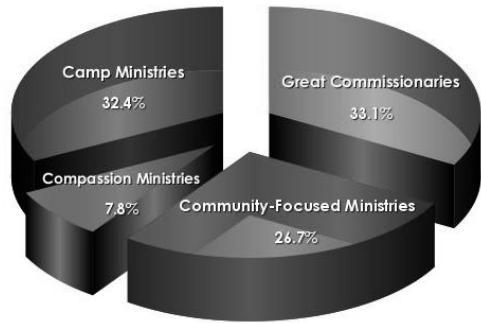
