The modern theologian Wayne Grudem expresses it this way, "The authority of Scripture means that all the words in Scripture are God's words in such a way that to disbelieve or disobey any word of Scripture is to disbelieve or disobey God." (Systematic Theology, 73). What a world of difference it would make if we were to believe 2 Timothy 3:16-17. May God place in our hearts the desire for His Word.
